But in the midst of the audience, three spectators were undoubtedly the most impatient: Pierre Courbon (12), Alexis Cavaglia (15) and Sébastien Solari (34). These three young disabled people from Millery and Charly had waited to meet the star in the flesh at the beginning of the performance, but they had to wait until the end. Pierre, too tired, unfortunately had to leave beforehand.

A meeting organized by the Deputy for the 11th riding, Georges Fenech, with the "Rêves" association for Isère led by Annick Gambin and his friends from the show biz world. "I had the opportunity to meet Lionel Ritchie thanks to his agent, Pascal Renouard de Vallière. I said okay, as long as I can let some of our young disabled youth enjoy it," he explains. Annick Gambin selected Alexis, Pierre and Sébastien, all three very committed to the Millery Telethon, which she also manages.
